Your Responsibilities as Team Captain:

As a team captain you will be responsible for recruiting your team members, collecting money from team members for the entry fee, and passing on important information to your team. Camp Hantesa staff will communicate directly with you regarding the Survivor Challenge event but will not be communicating with individual team members, you will be their primary contact!

What to Expect:
